Teamsters for a Democratic Union ("TDU"), an independent committee, filed a preelection protest pursuant to Article XIII, Section 2(b) of the Rules for the 2005-2006 IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election ("Rules"). The protest alleged that the local union election plan for GCA 480 erroneously stated that there was only one union bulletin board, and failed to include a worksite list, in violation of the Rules.

By email sent June 1, 2006, TDU requested to withdraw this protest.

Accordingly, we grant the protestor's request and deem this protest WITHDRAWN.

Any interested party not satisfied with this determination may request a hearing before the Election Appeals Master within two (2) working days of receipt of this decision.
