Gentlemen

A pre-election protest was filed pursuant to the Rules for the IBT International Union Delegate and Officer Election, revised August 1, 1990 ("Election Rules") The protest alleges that Messrs Camarata and Wade were "assaulted" outside the offices of Local Union 299 by two members of Local 299, one a steward The alleged assault involved the two members "screaming" at them and using profanity as Messrs Camarata and Wade were distributing Ron Carey literature and Ron Carey Slate accreditation petitions

While the Election Officer finds that this behavior in fact occurred, he also finds that it was not encouraged or subsequently ratified by the Officers of Local 299 Further, neither protester alleges, and the Election Officer does not find, that this confrontation intimidated either Mr Camarata or Mr Wade

However, behavior of the sort that occurred in this case is infantile, and may well lead to members being less willing to participate Pete Camarata Gary Wade Rondal C Owens December 5, 1990 Page 2
