In response to a request for pre-nomination eligibility verification on January 18, 1996, the Election Officer found that Michael Young, a member of Local Union 705, was not eligible to run for delegate to the International convention. By letter received by the Election Officer on January 22, 1996, Mr. Young protests this determination. An investigation revealed that Mr. Young was not nominated for delegate and that the deadline for nominations in Local Union 705 has passed. As a result, the issue raised in this protest is moot and the protest is DENIED.
